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## Summer Full Immersion Program

### Q: What is the philosophy of the Summer Program?

A: Our Summer Program offers a unique blend of Full Immersion Mandarin learning and fun activities. We offer age-appropriate choices that are varied and stimulating. The Summer Program is staffed by experienced and creative educators. We strive to challenge children love and curiosity of Mandarin learning and Chinese Culture. Our goal is to see students improve in their Mandarin and Chinese Culture learning and use the language.

### Q: When is the Summer Program?

A: The Summer Program is from June 20th to Aug. 5th.

Session 1: June 20<sup>th</sup>– July 1<sup>st</sup>, Session 2: July 5<sup>th</sup> –July 15<sup>th</sup>, Session 3: July 18<sup>th</sup> –July 29<sup>th</sup> and Session 4: July 18<sup>th</sup> – Aug 5<sup>th</sup>.

Students may combine sessions or add more weeks to the session. Make sure to clearly state in your Registration Forms.

### Q: Can you tell me a typical day of the summer camp?

A: Students gather in our gym for morning exercise and singing. Teachers will then bring students to their designated classrooms.

Children age 3 to 4 may join a half-day or a full-day program. Learning include indoor and outdoor activities. Activities comprise of singing, dancing, story time, art and craft, snack time, indoor gym and outdoor park activities, nap time, live chat with our overseas Mandarin speaking friends, etc. Parents are invited to come and learn with their children before half-a-day pick up.

Children age 4 to 12 join our full day program. Learning include indoor and outdoor activities. Activities include text book reading, conversation time, writing, calligraphy, Chinese painting, Chinese traditional movie in school theater, live chat with our overseas Mandarin speaking friends, art and craft, indoor gym and outdoor park activities, badminton, basketball, Mandarin version of Minute to Win It, and outside school activities, such as swimming with our providers

Children age 12 to 17 join our half-day program. Activities include text book reading, conversation time, writing, calligraphy, Chinese painting, live chat with our overseas Mandarin speaking friends, discussions on current affair.

### Q: Can you tell me more about the Culture learning?

A: Every week there will be a different theme as the core of the week learning. Students learn about Chinese New Year, Lantern Festival, Mooncake Festival, History of China, China Olympic, Chinese music and more. We will send details to parents before school begins.

**Q: I know you have a great program that helps our family learns Mandarin and Chinese Culture, can you tell us more about it?**

A: Our school emphasizes on friendly learning environment and full support. Besides your child learning in school, if your family needs extra learning, please feel free to contact our Director off school hours. If Mandarin is your first language, we also welcome that you contact the school if you would like to chat with our Director about your child daily learning. Our school staff members enjoy helping your family learn and are here to support you!

**Q: Where is the Summer Program?**

A: The Summer Program mainly conducted in our school at The Hudson School, 601 Park Avenue, Hoboken, NJ 07030. Some outdoor activities such as swimming will be held at our outside providers in Hoboken and Jersey City. Students will also go to parks in Hoboken.

**Q: When is the Registration deadline?**

**Q: Do the students have to bring lunch and snack to school?**

A: Yes. Students must bring lunch, snack and water, juice or milk to school. However, there will be some healthy snacks on-site for students who forget to bring their own food.

**Q: Is it a nuts-free environment?**

A: It is not nuts-free but we are nuts-aware. Parents please make sure food and drink your child brings to school are nuts-free. Our snacks are nuts-free. Children are not allowed to share food in school.

**Q: Does school provide bus service for pick up and drop off?**

A: We do not provide bus transportation, but are in contact with a bus company that will pick up your child to and from school for an additional fee. All bus arrangements are handled through the bus company and the interested parties. The bus stops at Hamilton Park, Exchange Place, Van Vorst Park, Newport.

### Q: What should my child bring to school?

A: All students must bring their lunch, snacks, water, juice or milk. sun-block lotion,

Children age 3-4 must bring a toy to school and the toy will be kept in school during the entire duration as we will be using these toys as teaching material. The idea is to have them learn with toy they like and relate that in Mandarin.

Children age 3-4 who are not yet potty trained, must bring diaper, wipe, oilment, lotion.

Children age 3-4 Full time students must bring blanket and if they like something that help them with their nap (doll, pillow, etc).

Children age 4-12 must bring pencil, crayon, note books, drawing pad, a pair of sandals, badminton racket, towel, paint brush, Chinese writing book, calligraphy brush.

Children age 12-17 must bring pencil, note book, drawing pad, Chinese paint brush, calligraphy brush.

If you prefer school help you purchase Chinese writing book, Chinese paint brush, calligraphy brush, please contact school during Registration.
